



Conditions of Entry for National Championships and National Competitions FINAL STAGES

All entrants will conform to the following conditions should they qualify for the final stages (Leamington and Worthing) in more than one event.

National Championships will always take priority over other events wherever possible.

National Championships are defined as:

- Junior Singles
- Junior Pairs (women only)
- Two-Wood Singles (women only)
- Four-Wood Singles
- Pairs
- Triples
- Fours

The remainder are defined as National Competitions, including Johns Trophy and Middleton Cup.

In the event of a competitor/s qualifying for more than one event during the National Championships and National Competitions finals, National Championships will take priority. Therefore, there is an expectation that players will choose to prioritise playing in National Championships in all cases.

If a clash occurs between an individual/s and an event involving more than four players (Middleton Cup/Balcomb Trophy/White Rose Trophy/Tony Allcock Trophy/Johns Trophy/Walker Cup/Amy Rose/Club Two Fours and Top Club included) it will be expected that substitutes will be found from other squad members.

The Championship Committee will prioritise the timetable for National Championships wherever possible. The Championship Committee will attempt to accommodate the player/s concerned wherever possible subject to:

- *the prior agreement of all parties involved;*
- *time;*
- *green availability;*
- *avoidance of disruption to other competitors and other events*

Competitors will enter under the full understanding that these conditions apply and that, in all cases, *the decision of the Championship Committee will be final.*
